The Department of Mathematics and Statistics at Oakland University invites applications for a tenure-track position at the rank of Assistant Professor in the area of Algebra.

Responsibilities of this position include teaching, research, and contribution to the Department's Ph.D. program in applied mathematics. For appointment, candidates must have a Ph.D. in Algebra (or its requirements completed) by August 15, 2010.

The primary selection criteria will be an applicant's potential for quality research and effective teaching in support of the Department's instructional responsibilities including all levels of undergraduate mathematics as well as graduate mathematics in algebra and related areas. Amongst applicants who are found highly qualified with respect to these criteria, preference will be given to those with strong research potential and evidence of experience and/or potential in developing research links and/or student projects which lead to external funding.

The Department of Mathematics and Statistics has 25 full-time faculty members who have research strengths in pure and applied mathematics and statistics. The Department offers baccalaureate degrees in mathematics and statistics, master's degrees in mathematics, industrial and applied mathematics and applied statistics and, a Ph.D. in Applied Mathematical Sciences with concentrations in three different areas including Applied Discrete Specialization.
